April 1-9, 2026 (Pesach)
(our Good Friday is Apr. 3, 2026)

Christ's crucifixion, redeemed, saved from slavery, remember passed over from death by the blood, sacrificial lamb offering, help needy

Unleavened Bread

April 1-7, 2026 (communion)

Remember Christ's atoning death and burial; hastily left Egypt, purge all sin (leaven), Trinity: Father, Son, Holy Spirit

grain harvest starts, barley harvest, spring rain

First Fruits

April 2, 2026

(our Easter is Apr. 20, 2026)

Remember Christ's resurrection

the first fruit until Pentecost/Shavout

general harvest, wheat harvest, start of dry season

Pentecost

May 21-23, 2026

Feast of Shavout (weeks)

Harvest, 50 days after Christ's resurrection

Holy Spirit outpouring, church began, help needy

Month 8 Oct./Nov. (Heshvan)

grain planting, plowing and late figs
